Do you want to become an expert maneuvering in your wheelchair?

Learn to:

- Reverse your wheelchair
- · Go ground corners
- Repositioning & reclining in your chair
- Going up and over gutters
- Going through doorways
- Navigating tight spaces like hallways and corridors, and maneuvering over uneven ground
- Safe loading and unloading from vehicles

Participants will have the opportunity to learn from experienced wheelchair users and go through training drills to perfect their new skills as well as socialising and making new friends.

Everyone attending all the training sessions on the day will receive a certificate of attendance and will be automatically entered into the active users' events following on from the training.
